New Developments at Sutherland House School

Planned new developments are taking place in relation to Upper School.

For some time now the Governors have been considering the need to extend the school's provision by relocating and expanding at Secondary level. This is due to a number of reasons which include an increase in the number of requests for admissions at Secondary transfer and an increasingly diverse student group in terms of ability and curriculum requirements.

A property has now been purchased adjacent to our KS4/Post 16 provision and has planning permission and DCSF approval. This property has distinct advantages for students, creating an educational complex for Upper School provision, and enabling us to extend our provision from 84 to 94 pupils over a two year period.

This is a very exciting project and one that will extend and develop our provision further.
