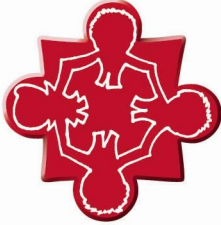
Our Vision and Mission

NORSACA's aims and objectives are:

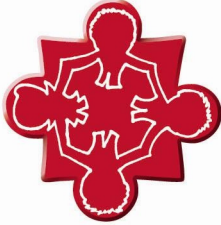
1. To enable people to make everyday choices

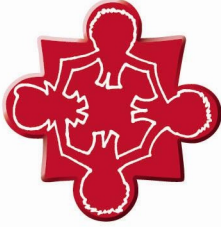
